## CONDITIONS FOR LOW-POWER BOATING ON LAKE LENAPE

1. Boats shall be a maximum of 20 feet in length. Maximum mast height is 20 feet.
2. Launching is permitted only at the designated sites. Boat ramp hours are posted at the Lake Lenape Ramp, 7:30 till ½ hour after sunset.
3. Boats with engines of 9.9 horsepower or less are registered as a low-power boats. Boats with engines of 10 horsepower and above are registered as high-power boats.
4. Permits are obtained through at the Lake Lenape Boat House office, 6303 Old Harding Highway, Mays Landing, between the hours of 7:30 am and 5:00 pm seven days a week. (609-625-8219).
5. The power boat application expires at the end of each calendar year, a \$5.00 processing fee is required. The check can be payable to the Atlantic County Treasurer.
6. All boats with motors must be registered. Operators shall demonstrate a boat operator's license endorsement (or safety completion if under 16). A valid New Jersey Boat Registration. Power Boats over 9.9 HP must carry at least \$500,000 of marine liability insurance in an approval form.
7. High-Power boating daily permits are issued for each specific day on a first come first served basis. Permits are nontransferable. Boaters failing to arrive by 2:00 p.m. shall forfeit their permit. Permits may be revoked at any time due to dangerous conditions or conduct.
8. Any operator of a vessel that is motorized in anyway must have a valid boaters endorsement to operate upon Lake Lenape.
9. Any boat with a motor may operate between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and one half hour after sunset. Boats not permitted to be docked as a registered homeowner must be removed from the lake by one half hour after sunset.
10. Maximum speed of any boat shall not exceed 40 MPH.
11. No powerboat shall operate within 200 feet of any swimming area. All boats shall operate to avoid danger and injury to all persons or manner of vessel, whether floating, mooring, anchored, or underway, to piers, wharves, bulkheads, or other waterfront construction, whether directly, or by the effect of the wave or wave raised by the boat through its speed
12. No person shall operate any vessel in a reckless or negligent manner. Boaters shall obey the directives of Park Rangers or authorized County representatives at all times.
13. All vessels are subjected to Coast Guard Rules of the Road, and must pay heed to all regulatory buoys.
14. No persons shall operate or permit another person to operate, a vessel while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
15. No swimming or diving from boats.
16. Parasailing and operation of personal water craft (jet skies, etc.) is prohibited.
17. Launching inflatable are prohibited, unless being towed behind a ski boat.
18. Boat owners and operators agree to indemnify and hold harmless the County of Atlantic its elected officials, agents, servants and claims, actions, expenses, judgments, subrogation, other expenses or liability by reason of any real or alleged injury to any person arising out of or incidental to use of any water craft on Lake Lenape.
19. Each boat is required by State law to possess all required safety equipment for that vessels size classification, occupancy and intended use (exp. skiing, fishing, rowing ect.).Each operator will know and produce upon request of any enforcement official that equipment required.
