Pneumonia Clinic

There is no out-of-pocket fee for Medicare Part B recipients who present their Medicare card. Individuals who do not have Medicare Part B will be charged a fee of \$25.00.

Men's Health Clinic

Men age 40 years and older can have a free health examination including:

Women's Health Clinic

Women 18 years and older can have a free exam which includes:

Blood Pressure, Blood Sugar, Breast Exam, Cholesterol, Colorectal screening (age 50 and over), Health Counseling, Mammogram Referral, Pap Smear, Pelvic Exam.

Appointments are available at the Stillwater Building in Northfield or at William Kessler Memorial Hospital in Hammonton.
